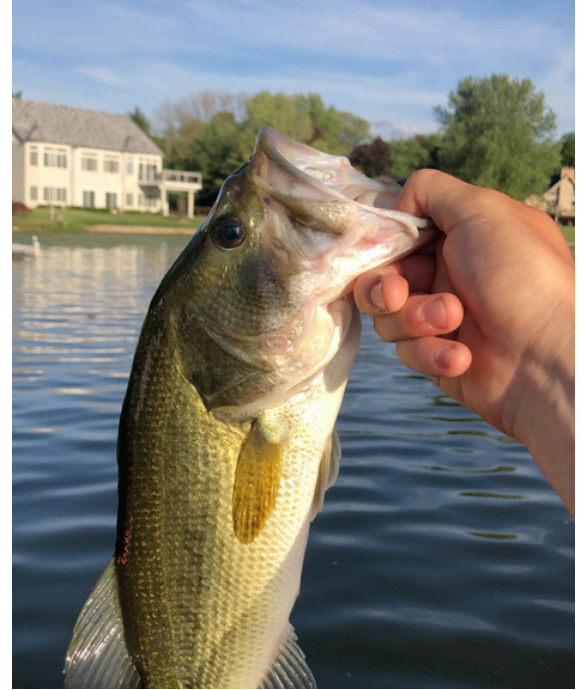


Fishery



LAKE ANTIOCH FISHING LIMITS



To maintain proper health and balance in our fishery, we must pay close attention to the prescribed fishing limits of our lake. These limits are based on studies which show the current fish population and comparative sizes that are appropriate for a lake of our size. Below is a summary of the catch limits.

PLEASE NOTE: In recent fish surveys, we've noticed a reduction in large Bluegills (9" or larger). Therefore, it is critical to release all Bluegill 9" or larger because these "Bulls" naturally guard the bluegill nests and ensure a healthy Bluegill population. When releasing these bluegill and other fish in the "Catch and Release" category such as Musky, Norther Pike, Bass, and Perch, please handle these fish with care to they can continue to thrive for generations to come.
